*Center closed December 24th and 25th for the Christmas Holiday

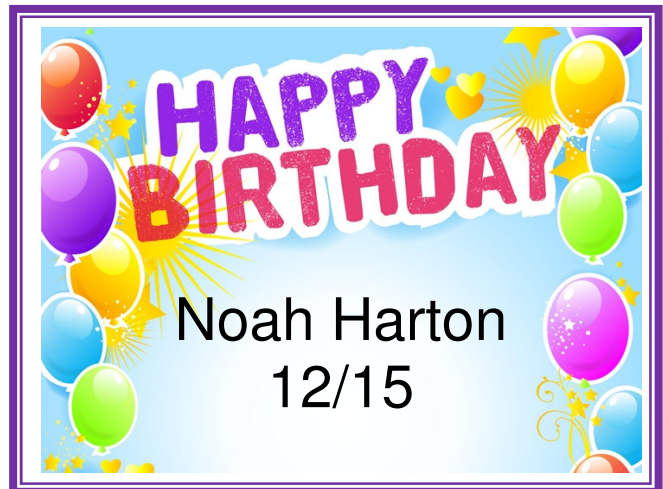
Reminders
